TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Bursaries are offered to students who have been enrolled more than one year and whose families are experiencing financial difficulties. Bursaries may be granted to more than one child in a family.

Bursaries may be offered to students participating in schools programs at the discretion of the CEO and school principal.

Bursary applications are assessed using the information provided in SECTION ONE or SECTION TWO (above). The information you supply will help determine your eligibility for financial assistance and will be **strictly confidential**.

Bursaries will usually constitute 50% of tuition fees on ONE instrument. In exceptional circumstances, this assistance may be increased.

Bursaries will provide assistance for one year from application. A new application must be made at the end of the 12 month period.

The successful applicant MUST

- 1 Pay the balance of the total cost of lessons after the bursary has been applied.
- 2 Commit to learning the instrument for the full year with Young Regional Conservatorium.
- 3 Pay all outstanding fees before applying for a bursary
- 4 Attend relevant workshops and masterclasses conducted by Young Regional Conservatorium at no cost to the student.
- 5 Be willing, where skills allow, to belong to any relevant musical groups and to perform in YRC Concerts.
- 6 Attend scheduled lessons and notify the YRC office where attendance is genuinely impossible. (In this case, lessons may be made up in accordance with the normal procedures of the conservatorium).
- 7 Notify YRC should a **change in circumstances** negate the need for a bursary.

Please note that the Board reserves the right to withdraw the bursary at any time should student commitments not be met.
